- Increase the understanding of evidence.

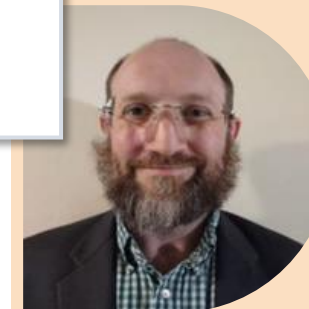
### Texas used CLEAR to:

- **Evaluate** studies that applicants plan to replicate using similar studies already reviewed and rated in CLEAR.
- **Aid** the original development of requests for application.
- **Discover** gaps in research and grant making areas.

### DOL's Clearinghouse for Labor Evaluation and Research (CLEAR) provided Texas with:

- Something that was very user-friendly.
- Something that was easy to understand.
- Something that people could use and review and access quickly.
